Great News! We will open the Aquarina Golf Course on November 1, 2009. We are confident that the sale will be finalized in the near future. Meanwhile, we are going to lease the course from the current owner for a year (the lease will terminate with the purchase of the golf course). Mr. Dan Murray will assume the lease in the interim and eventually lease it from ACSA after the sale is final. They intend to update the current snack bar this season and in the summer completely renovate it into a restaurant. In order to have the course playable by November 1, 2009, Dan Murray will start working on the course on or around September 28, 2009. We will need start-up money to accomplish this. We are asking for a deposit of \$1000 toward your membership. Everyone who pays this deposit by October 15, 2009, will have their initiation fee waived and one year free bag storage (2 for a couple and one for a single). This will be on a first come basis.
