

This 1964 Chevy Nova has an open Nevada "Dismantling" title and partially completed Nevada paperwork to get it back to a regular title. There is a scanned copy of the ownership documents you will receive available at www.whitleyauction.com. This is all you will get with these parts. This may or may not be enough to get a title in your state. Do your research and make your own decision.

There is no engine, no transmission and radiator sold with this car. We have not made an exhaustive inventory of what is included. It is certainly not 100% complete. It has a lot of potential. The entire front end of the car appears to have been rebuilt with new parts. The frame for the top appears to be all there and in decent condition. There are two old replacement front fenders. There is a replacement rear quarter panel for the damaged spot on the driver's side. You may be able to notice in some of the photos that it originally was an SS from the paint fading where the rear emblems were. There are two new old stock SS emblems that will be sold separately. There are also some replacement items that will be sold separately.

This will sell with the following parts that are not currently attached to the car: front bumper, front grill, cowl, replacement quarter panel for drivers side rear, steering column, large box of original body part bolts & screws, 2 Fisher door sills, what appears to be about all the original chrome and Stainless Steel molding & trim, original wiring harness, original chassis parts, new hood hinges, new cross member, original lighting, Hurst shifter, brake lines, chrome dash pieces, battery tray, 2 glove compartment doors, headlight housings and trim, wiper arms, radio & trim, original gauge cluster with Super Tach (very sun faded) & replacement gauge cluster, original front springs, original seats that have decent rusty steel springs & frames and need completely recovered, two new front wheels and tires on car and matching rear wheels and tires not on car, 2 original rear wheels & tires and one beauty ring and more. There are many parts with this car. If you are concerned about what is actually there come inspect it all yourself. We believe this list to be correct but it is not guaranteed.
