This year, the auction consignments were closed in mid January.

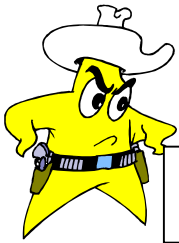

### IMPORTANT NOTES AND REFERENCES TO CATALOG DESCRIPTIONS

We will sell the entire auction by sequential lot number. At **8:50 A.M.** we will start with opening remarks. At **9:00 A.M.**, we will sell pre-lotted firearm accessories, loading equipment, ammo and related. The first 100 attendees will receive a free catalog of this portion of the auction. **Not before 10:00 A.M.**, we will start on the Gun Catalog Auction. Hopefully, we can meet this time line. **GUN SELLING ORDER:** The *Gun* Auction will begin with the BB Guns (Lot #300+) then back to Lot #1 and follow the catalog sequentially. Please note there may be blank or unused lot numbers. But again, we will not begin on the Gun Catalog before 10:00 A.M. However, it could be later. If applicable, BB Guns, lots 300+, will sell just prior to the Gun Catalog. Since the entire auction will be pre lotted, it will be possible to estimate when your desired lot number will sell.

## Laws & Forms

We can quickly process all the forms and background checks, and cash you out of the auction if you help us with all the necessary forms. **Please Read:**

### IMPORTANT LAWS & PROCEDURES

In an effort to abide by all federal, state and local laws, as well as to minimize check out time, our firm has prepared the following guidelines for firearm buyers.

#### The basic laws are as follows:

1. All buyers must have proper photo identification, satisfactory to all laws.
2. Buyers of long arms must be at least 18 years of age. If the buyer is in attendance at the auction, we can sell to any state that does not disallow out-of-state purchases (Example: California). We do not accept out-of-state absentee bids except from FFL holders.
3. Buyers of handguns must be at least 21 years of age and a resident of the State of Ohio.
4. Black Powder Firearms (short or long, excluding "in-line firearms") are not subject to any ATF regulations, therefore no NICS, no form 4473, and no restriction on residency.

#### BRADY LAW PROVISIONS

1. The permanent provisions of the 1993 "Brady Hand Gun Violence Prevention Act," which became effective November 30, 1998, requires background checks through the FBI & National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS), and will apply at this auction.
2. Buyers are required to complete and sign ATF form 4473 (5300.9), Revised August 2008 on all firearm purchases.
3. All auction lots marked "**Brady**" require a background check with the FBI & NICS.
4. Auction lots marked "**Non-Brady**" are certain exceptions to the Brady Provisions, such as "Antique firearms manufactured prior to 1898 and not accepting ammunition readily available, or matchlock, flintlock, percussion cap, or similar type of ignition system, or replicas there of, whether actually manufactured before or after 1898."
5. Buyers of more than one handgun are required to have the ATF Form 3310.4 of 03/2009 mailed or faxed to the ATF National Tracing Center, a copy mailed to local or state law enforcement agency, and a copy retained in our files.
6. Background checks come back "instantly" as (1) proceed, (2) denied, or (3) delayed. If the report is "proceed," the firearms(s) will be transferred immediately. If "delayed", it could take 3 business days & the Buyer will need to pickup up the firearm at a later date. If "denied", the transaction cannot be made. You will be given literature as to the appeal process.

## OUR POLICY, TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Throughout the inventory process of this catalog, we have attempted to assure accuracy in the description and representations. Due to printing deadlines, the owner of the firearm, and not a Kramer & Kramer Inc. staff member, may have provided some descriptions. **We cannot and do not guarantee any authenticity of any item.** Therefore, all items are sold **“as is, where is”** with the bidder having the sole responsibility as to determining the value, condition, age and authenticity of all items in this auction. No statement in this catalog, or by persons associated with the auction firm shall be deemed to be a warranty in any fashion with respect to age and authenticity. Any and all statements, and written matters are only opinions, and not to be interpreted as warranty. Verbal statements made day of auction take precedence over all written material.
2. **Absentee bids** are accepted in good faith, as a service to our sellers. A credit card number is required, and items will be shipped at buyer’s risk and cost. Absentee bids are handled by experienced bidders with right to open bids at 75% of the bid. After the opening bid, the bidding is done in a competitive manner. There is a 15% Buyers Premium charged on all absentee bids, payable to the auction firm.
3. The buyer assumes 100% responsibility of articles at the time of purchase. All risk of damage or loss is borne by the purchaser at the time the auctioneer says, “Sold.”
4. In the event of a tied or disputed bid, the auctioneer is the sole determinant as to who is the successful bidder. Small bids are made in a manner, which the auctioneer may deem detrimental to the auction may be refused. Once an item is sold ... it is SOLD!
5. All purchases are to be paid for the day of the auction by cash, check, visa or MasterCard. Personal checks accepted only from established customers. If a buyer is in doubt as to whether a personal check will be accepted, they should bring a cashier’s check or money order. Visa and MasterCard are also accepted at no additional charge.
6. Ohio sales tax is applicable at this auction. (Note: Only FFL Holders with a Vendor’s Number are exempt on “Brady” Firearms).
7. The auction will be audio tape-recorded. The auctioneer reserves the right to videotape any and all activity in and during the auction. Purchasers will have their photos taken at registration & checkout.
8. Bidders should read Terms and Conditions of Auction, stated on their bidding cards, as it has further terms and conditions of the auction.
9. The Auctioneer shall have the privilege to combine lots, or offer multiple lots in a “choice fashion.” In a “choice fashion,” the high bidder can take choice of the lots offered, either one or multiple choices, times the high bid.
10. Bidders should read and familiarize themselves with AF forms 4473 & 3310, posted throughout the auction hall. Bidders must have a valid ID to purchase firearms.
11. Kramer & Kramer Inc. Auctioneers – Realtors are full time auctioneers licensed in Ohio and Indiana with over 99 years of combined faithful service. We conduct our auctions with integrity, and we expect our auction attendees to conduct themselves in a respectful manner and with integrity.

## SELLING AND SETTLEMENT PROCEDURES

1. When the auctioneer sells a firearm, the buyer will initial the catalog lot number to acknowledge being the high bidder, and given ATF form 4473. Complete the **FIRST PAGE OF THE FORM**, in ink, prior to going to the settlement line, but **DO NOT SIGN** the form until a clerk can witness your signature (*please have photo identification ready*). Samples are posted throughout the auction area for explanation on how to complete all of Section “A”, lines 1 thru 15. The form must be legible.
2. Buyers are required to present a valid government issued photo identification to the Kramer & Kramer Inc. staff when they sign the ATF Form 4473.
3. In order to receive your regulated firearm, you must pay the cashier **AND** your bid number must be posted on the white board. You can pay your account anytime ... but if you bought a regulated firearm (Brady) do not get in the 4473 lines until your bid number is posted on the white board.
4. Summary for Checking out and Receiving your Firearms:
  - Fill out 4473 form and present to clerks to start background check procedure
  - You may pay your account at anytime, and you will receive 2 paid receipts
  - Once your bid number is posted on the white board, take your paid receipts to the 4473 area
  - The 4473 checkout staff will finalize the form and give you a disbursal authorization sheet, which can be presented for your firearms once the “gate keeper” escorts you to the firearm disbursal area
  - NO ONE bypasses this system. Dealers and buyers of non-regulated firearms must go through the same lines to receive the disbursal authorization sheet. This is for our quality control and disbursal of all firearms
5. We will sell around 250 firearms, of which about 200 require background checks resulting in 150 to 175 checks. This is a tremendous task for our staff and we will try to keep the waiting lines to a minimum, so your help and patience is greatly appreciated.
6. All firearms are to be taken from the building immediately and not carried around the auction area.
7. Gun Dealers with FFL will need to present a signed copy of their license
8. Safety devices are for sale at the clerk’s table for \$35 each. Also available are handouts on ATF Youth Handout Safety Act Notice
9. Thank you for your attendance. We hope to see you next year at FIRARM XVIII – the last Saturday of January, 2011.

For safety, we have tied firearm triggers, hammers or actions so they cannot be fired. Firearms were in working condition, unless noted in catalog and at the time of securing the firing mechanism.

At the point of sale, we will untie the firearm and work the action. The successful Bidder may go to the display area to assure the action is in working condition. Under no circumstances will a sale be rescinded if, (a) the firing mechanism is working, or (B) after 15 minutes from the point of sale.

All sales are absolutely final at this point. We ask your understanding with this safety policy.

  - You will be charged a 20% restocking fee to resell and transfer the firearm to an eligible purchaser. This 20% restocking fee is not negotiable or refundable.
  - And you are responsible for damages to our consignor if the firearm sells for less than 80% of you original bid price.
